Walruses have a layer of blubber that helps keep them warm in cold water.






Both female and male walruses have tusks.

Then the woman turned her pants into a caribou. She gave the caribou tusks and set it free on the land. When the caribou saw a man, it harmed the man with its tusks.






The woman called the caribou and walrus to her. She put the tusks on the walrus and the antlers on the caribou. She kicked the caribou's head flat to punish it for harming the man.




