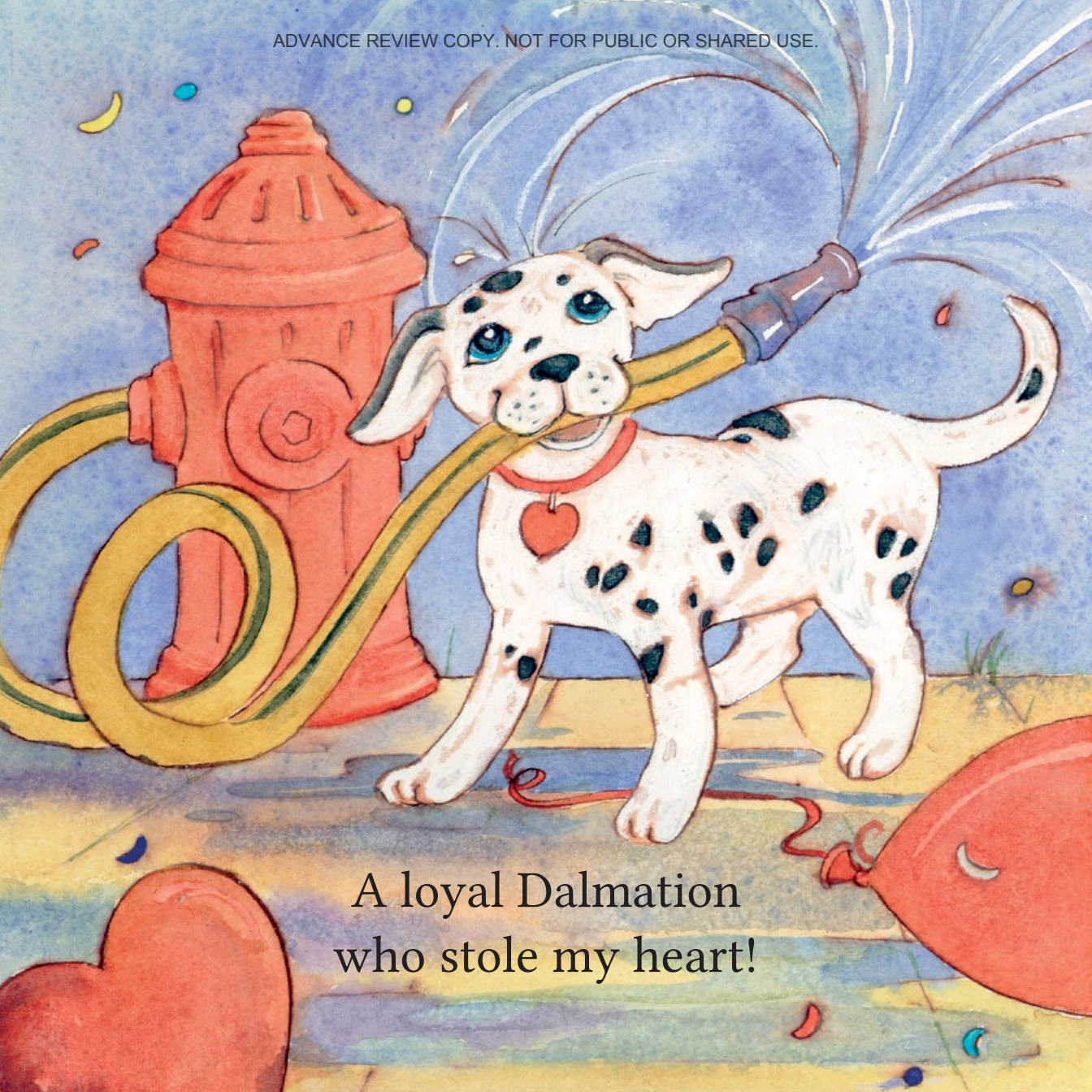

What kind of puppy could she be?



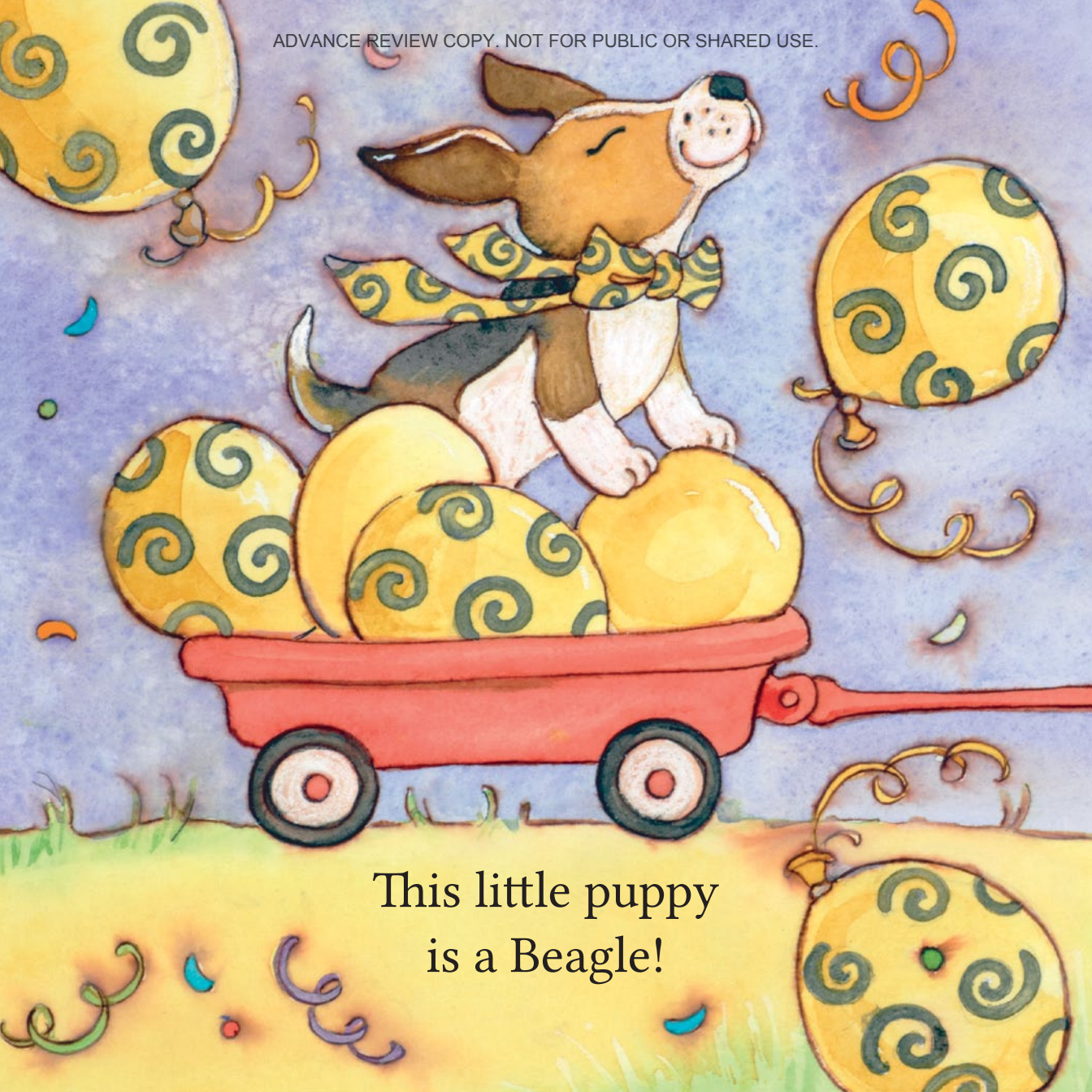
White coat. Black spots.
Friendly and smart.



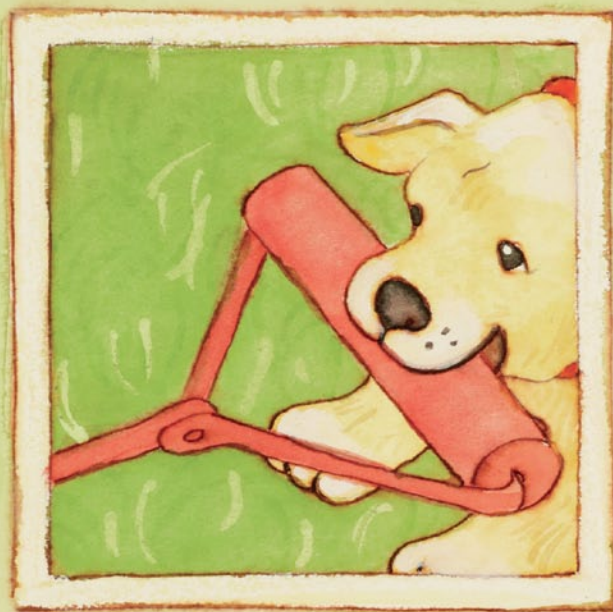
A loyal Dalmatian

is a Beagle!



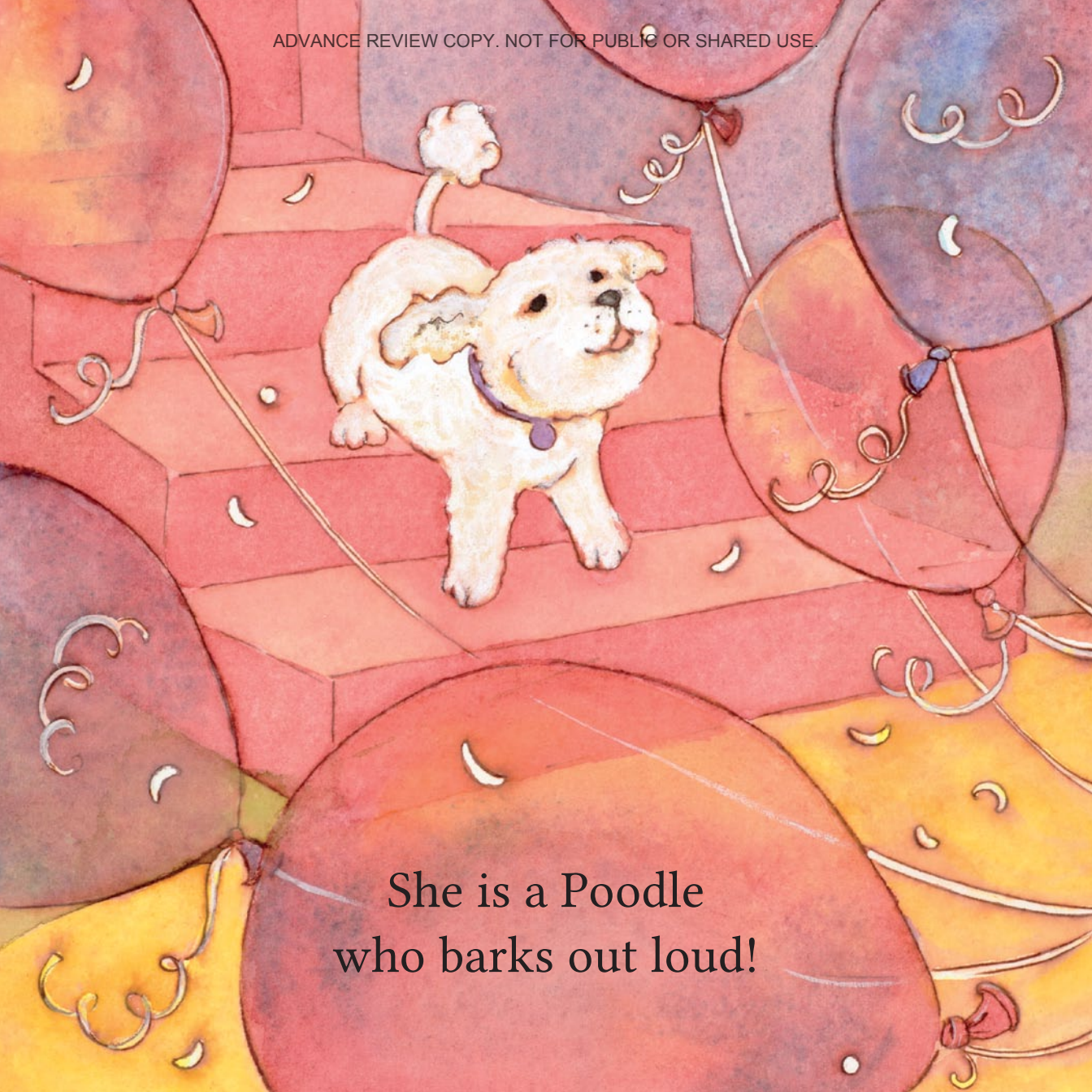
Here comes a puppy,

the color of sun!



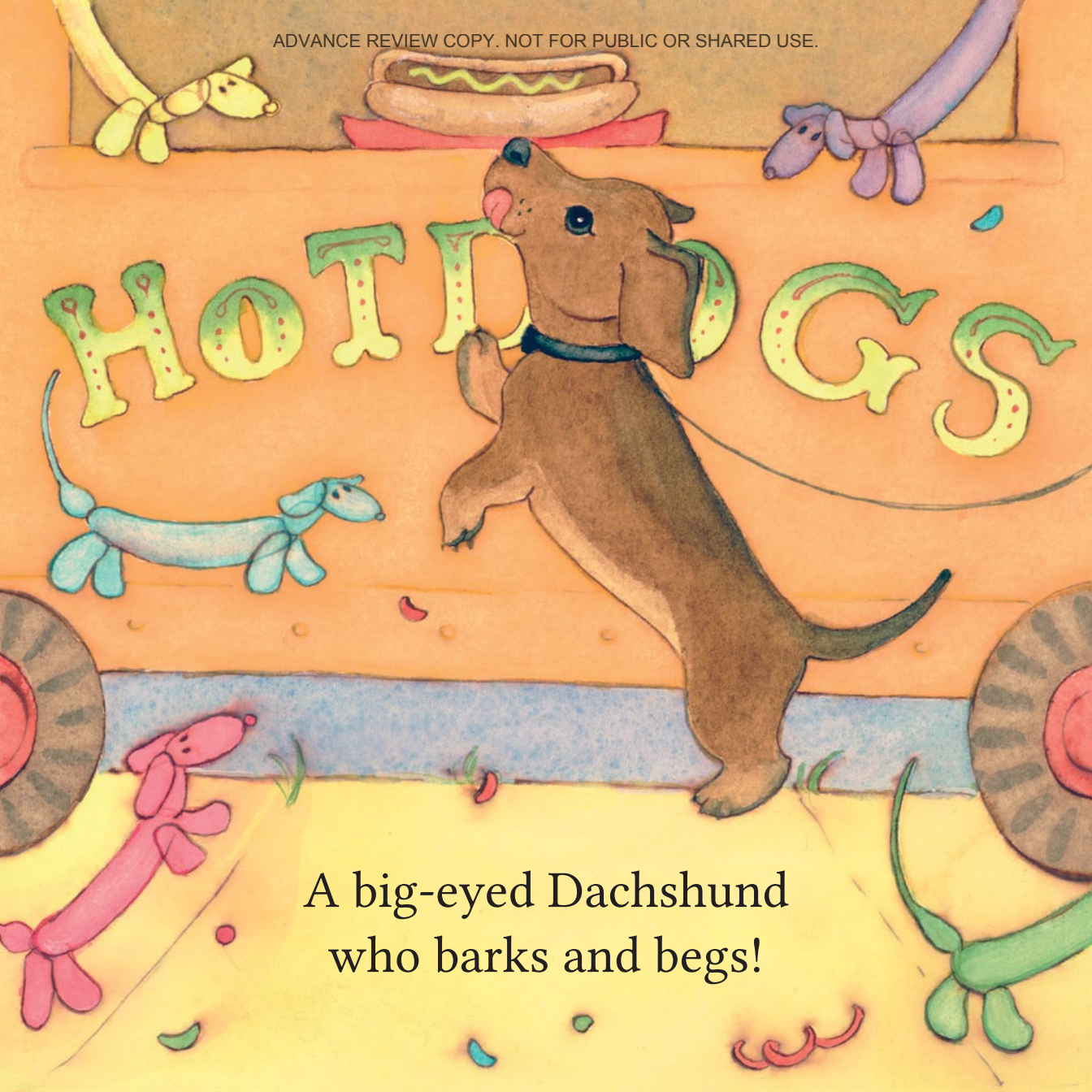
A clever puppy.

cute as a bug.



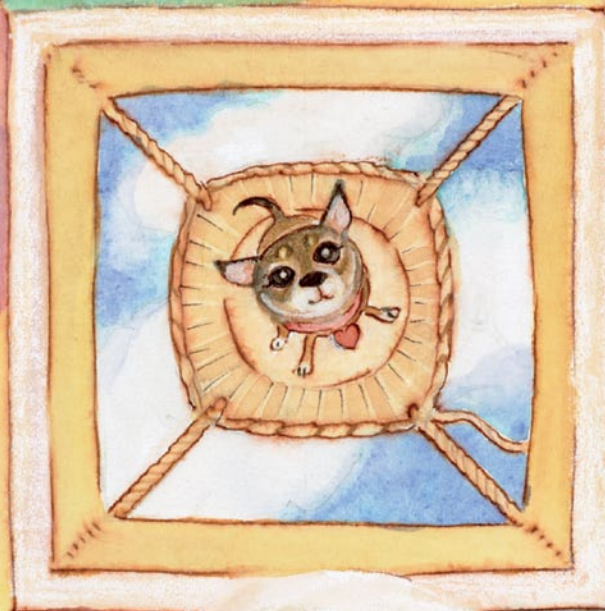
Here he comes.
A puppy called Pug!



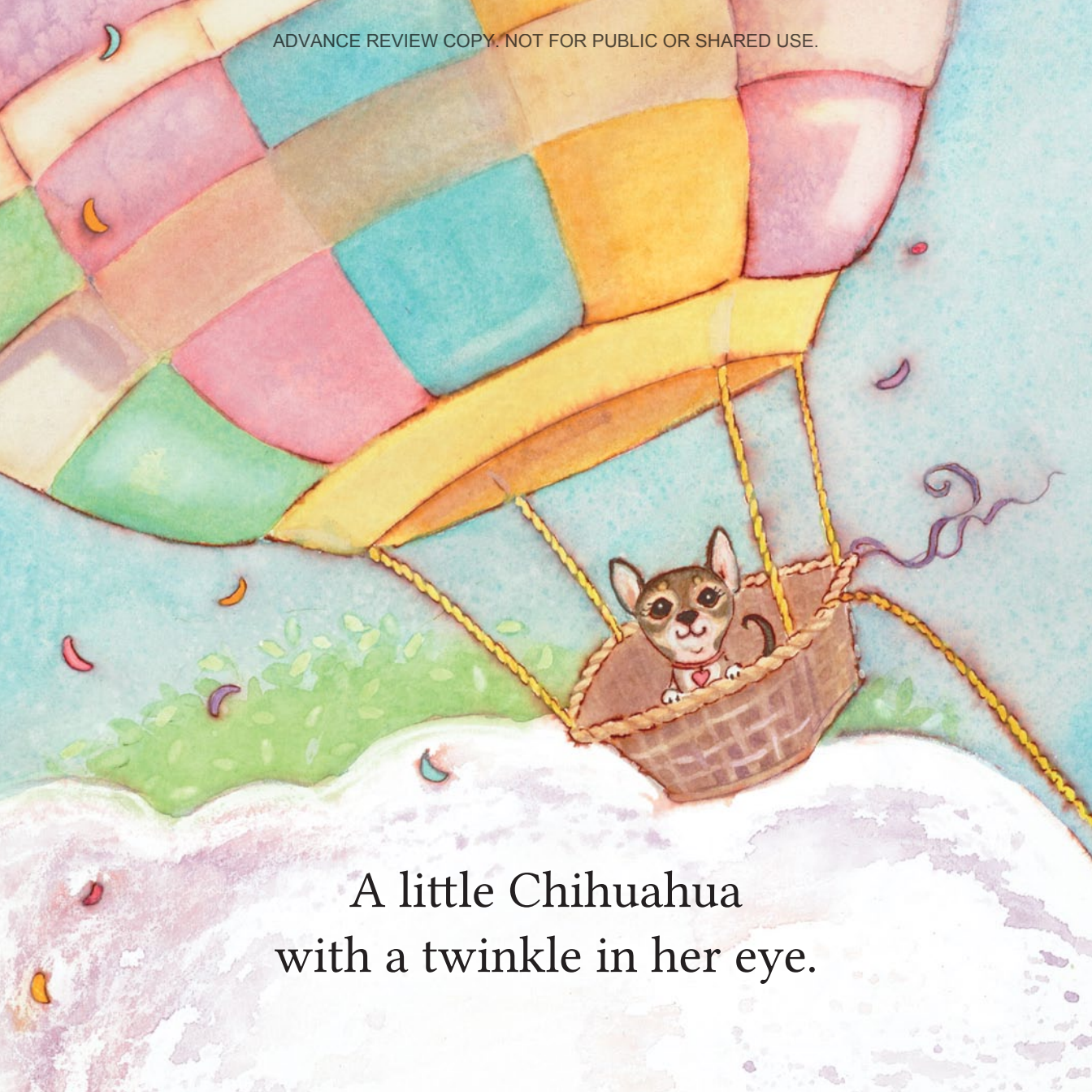
A perky little puppy.

Love at first sight!



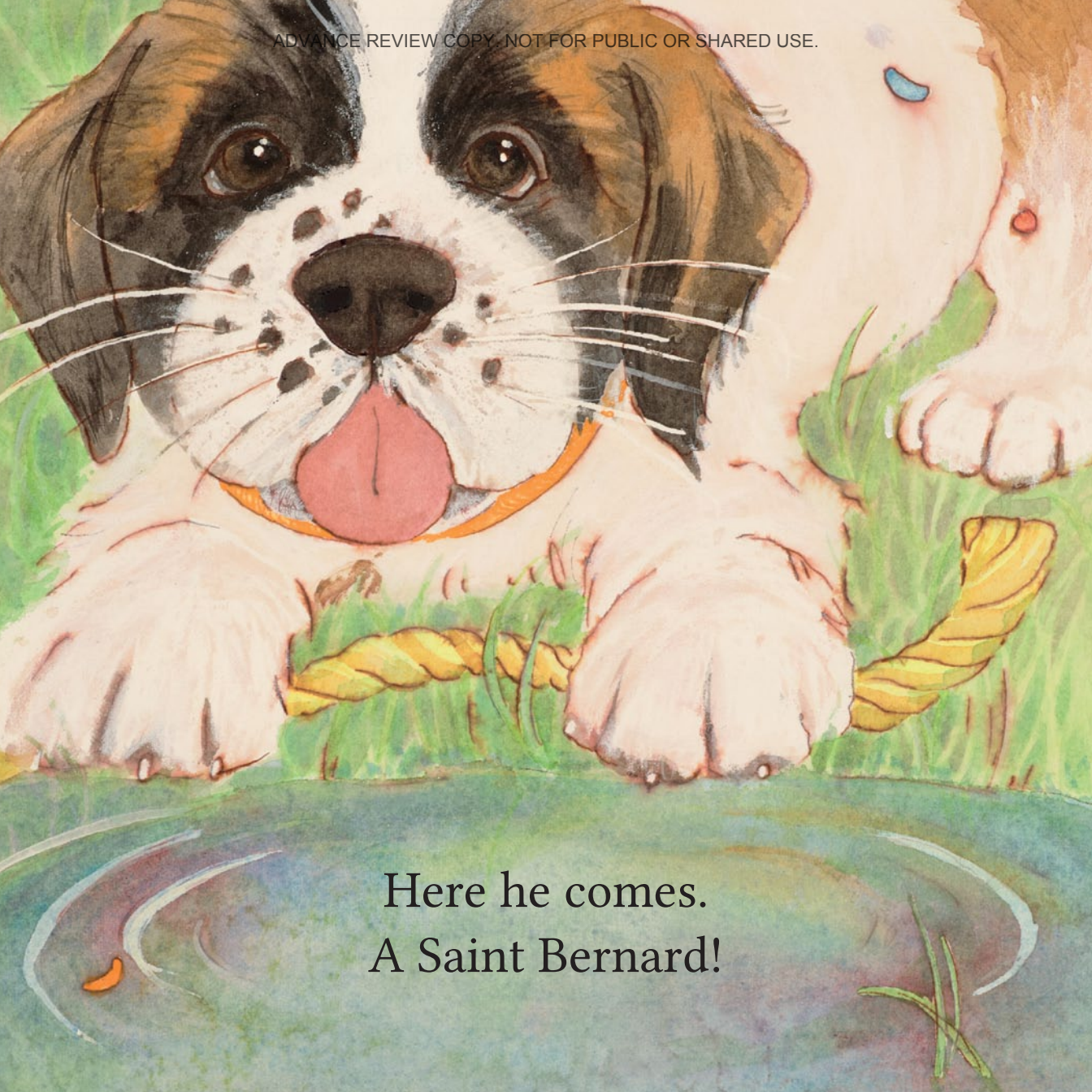
A tiny puppy.
