before the sky grows blue.

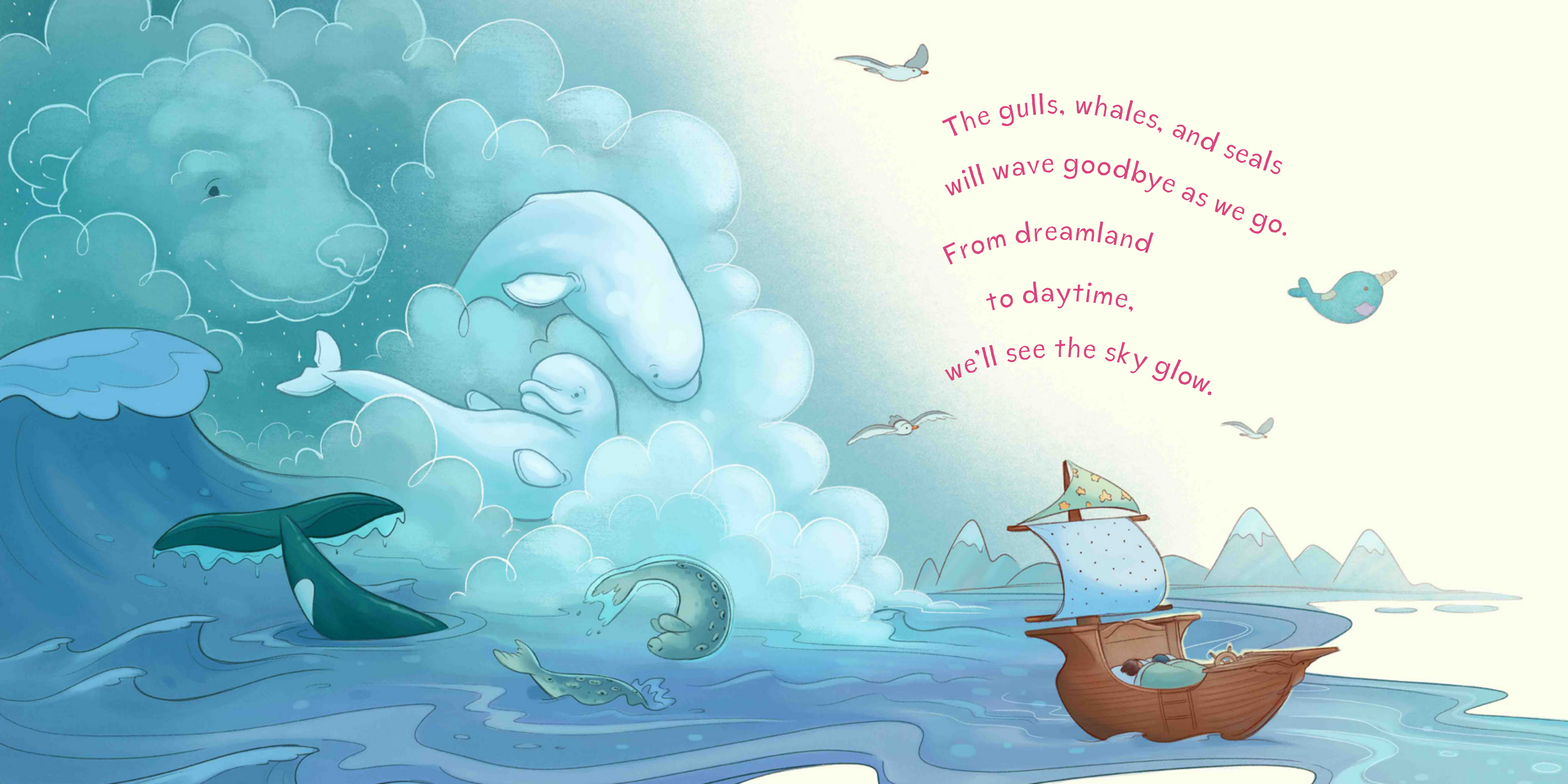




Soon the morning will come,
